The report is a positive one that continues to judge Waverton as a good school by maintaining a good quality of education for all the pupils. It states what the school does well, although clearly it doesn't capture everything, the key strengths and also identifies the areas we need to develop to further improve. We would again like to thank parents for their views posted on the Ofsted "Parent View" website and those who spoke to the inspectors in person on the day.

The governing body joins with school staff in welcoming the feedback in the Ofsted report. We have, since our last inspection, strategically planned and developed both the school and the governing body. Schools need to be challenged and it is quite right that the standards demanded from us are as high as they can be. The judgement for this school reflects all the hard work against a backdrop of continually changing goal-posts from central government: a new national curriculum (2014) and assessment without levels this year, alongside our own specific aims and goals, as well as the Common Assessment [Ofsted framework](#) (September 2015) and recently updated [Inspection Handbook](#) (August 2016).

The findings reported that require immediate attention will be the focus for our School Development Plan and will shape our future direction. We are eager and keen to meet the challenges ahead to continue to raise attainment and progress for all our children, whilst maintaining the warm and nurturing environment everyone has worked so hard to achieve.
