School Uniform / Dress code

Thanks to everyone for supporting the school uniform policy. The children have come back into school looking very smart. Please ensure that all items of clothing are clearly marked with your child's name.

A number of girls are coming to school with long hair which is not tied up. Please could you ensure that if your child has long hair they have a means to tie it up, particularly on days when they have PE, DT or Art activities. Children may wear small stud earrings, although it would be helpful if they were not worn on days when the children do PE or go swimming.
