Cheshire West and Chester Council offer SEND specific HAF sessions. Sessions will take place throughout this borough over the Winter period.

Sessions are designed to be free for Children with SEND who are on benefit-related Free School Meals. There is also an opportunity for Children who are not on Free School Meals to pay for places. To find out the costs of any places detailed within this booklet for those who are not on Free School Meals, please contact the provider directly through their contact details provided within this booklet.

Parents/carers will not be charged, to attend or support their child at any session.

There may be opportunities, at some of the HAF providers, to accommodate siblings (Please contact the provider you are choosing to discuss in further detail).

All sessions will come with the provision of a healthy food option as part of the HAF offer, which could consist of either hot or cold food dependent on the session and location of delivery.
