We are all looking forward to the whole school Sport's Day on Thursday 26th June. Fingers crossed that the weather will be kind - You will be notified by email before midday on the day if, due to bad weather, we have to cancel. We will then try again on Thursday 3rd July with timings and information above remaining the same.

The children will bring their PE kit home with them on Wednesday and they should come to school on Thursday dressed in their full PE kit. Please ensure they have sun cream applied before school and they have a cap and water bottle with them. **Only the entrance via the Village Hall car park will be open at 1.00pm.**

The entrance on Common Lane will not be open at this time.

There will be no seating provided, but you are more than welcome to bring along your own camping chairs and/or picnic blankets. Spectators should seat themselves on the side of the track furthest away from the school building.

Children will return to their classrooms at the end of the activities and can then be collected from their usual "end of day" pick up points.

Please do not cross the running tracks to see your child or collect them.

There will be no CEPD Year 1 & 2 Football after school on this day as previously notified.
